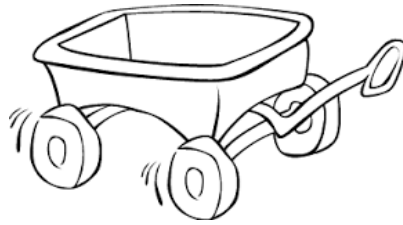

## Slawburger Wagon Parade Rules and Regulations



1. Standard four (4) wheel wagons only. No motorized vehicles of any description.
2. Wagons are limited in overall size to 48 inches long and 28 inches wide and 3 feet high from the base of the wagon, including all decoration, but not including the pull handle.
3. All decorations must be attached securely, for the parade will be on some uneven surfaces.
4. Wagon must be hand-pulled by a single person. Children may have adult assistance. Parade distance will be around the courthouse sidewalk. If the wagon represents a group that wishes to participate in the parade, 2-3 members of the group may walk behind their wagon.
5. Three categories: 1. Overall creativity 2. Level of difficulty 3. Best use of theme "Slawburger Festival ". *Judges' decision is final.*
6. Prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each category.
7. Parade will begin at 10:30 and proceed around the sidewalk of the square. Lineup will be at 10:15am on the East side of the courthouse close to the Bandstand, where you will receive a number.
8. **All rules will be strictly enforced. Parade Chairman's decision is final.**

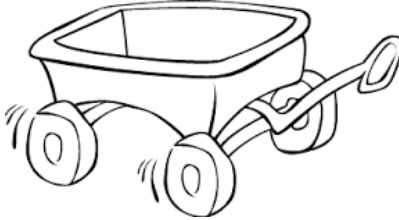
### What to do:

- Submit entry form and payment to the Main Street Office at 215 College Street E or mail to: Fay. Main Street - P.O. Box 162 on or before Wednesday, April 12, (12 noon) or the Slawburger Information Desk on East side of Square before 10am day of event.
- Entry fee is \$5.00 to April 12, (12 noon) and \$10.00 from April 12, (12 noon) to 10am day of event.
- Get a small wagon (it doesn't have to be a red one...just one you can pull).
- Decorate the wagon with whatever family friendly theme you would like. The only rule about a theme is that it must be a family friendly theme.
- Dress up to go with your theme and pull the wagon in the parade. Kids can enjoy pulling the wagon dressed in their favorite costumes that go with the theme.
- Only one person can pull the wagon, but others may dress up with the theme and walk next to the wagon. Children under the age of 4 must have a parent help them pull the wagon in the parade. For safety, a limit of two children may ride in the wagon. Others may walk next to the wagon.
- Bring your decorated wagon to the festival and check in at the parade check table in the Kids Zone.
- No candy or items may be given out to the audience by floats. Sorry, no animals/pets can be incorporated into the entries.
